

POTENTIAL EXHIBITOR/VISITOR/SPONSOR OF A VIRTUAL EXHIBITION/FAIR

AN INFORMATION CLAUSE ON THE RIGHTS OF THE PERSON, WHOSE PERSONAL DATA ARE PROCESSED

Please be informed that we process your personal data in the form of: name, surname, company, e-mail address, country and status in the context of participation in a virtual exhibition/fair.

The administrator of your data is World Expo International Sp. z o.o. (Ltd.), 246 Fordońska Street, 85-766 Bydgoszcz, Tax Identification Number (NIP): PL5542469090, entered in the register of entrepreneurs kept by the District Court in Bydgoszcz of the National Court Register under No. KRS: 0000106011, share capital: 51.000,00 PLN, e-mail: office@world-expo.com.pl.

If you agree to receive marketing content, you can withdraw your consent at any time by sending your request, for example, to the above e-mail address. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of data processing for the above mentioned purpose until the withdrawal of consent.

We also inform you that:

- a. The Administrator does not appoint a Data Protection Officer;
- b. The Administrator does not forward your personal data to international organisations;
- c. The Administrator does not transfer your personal data to the third-countries;
- d. As a general rule, the Administrator does not process your personal data in an automated way, including profiling;
- e. Your data is processed for the purpose of carrying out a business activity, i.e. the presentation of an offer to participate in a virtual exhibition/fair;
- f. The legal basis for the processing of your personal data is Article 6, paragraph 1, point b) of the General Data Protection Regulation (undertaking activities aimed at concluding an agreement to participate in a virtual exhibitions/fairs as well as providing electronic services); if you additionally consent to the transmission of marketing content, the basis for the processing of your personal data for this purpose will be Article 6, paragraph 1, point a) of the General Data Protection Regulation/GDPR (your consent);
- g. The administrator processes the above mentioned data of yours, which are normal personal data within the meaning of the GDPR;
- h. Your personal data may be transferred to employees, contractors, other counterparties;
- i. Your personal data will be processed until the time required by the purpose of the processing, but no longer than the time required by law;
- j. Your personal data has been collected directly from you via the contact form;
- k. The provision of your personal data is voluntary, but is necessary for the purpose indicated in point e.

In fulfilling the duty to provide information, we point out that you have a right:

- a. to access your personal data;
- b. to obtain a copy of the personal data processed;
- c. to rectify their personal data;
- d. to complete your personal data;
- e. to limitations on the processing of your personal data in situations where: -you question the accuracy of your personal data for a period of time allowing the administrator to verify the accuracy of the data; -the processing of the data is unlawful and you will oppose to the deletion of your personal data, requesting instead a restriction on its use; -the administrator no longer needs your personal data for the purposes of processing, but you need it to establish, pursue or defend your claims;
- f. to delete your personal data;
- g. to transfer of personal data;
- h. to object to the processing of data according to Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR and to the marketing activities of the administrator;
- i. to withdraw consent (if granted), whereby the withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the processing of your data for this purpose before it is withdrawn;
- j. to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority, the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection.

All rights shall be exercised by e-mail or registered letter. The administrator is obliged under Article 12(3) of the GDPR to inform you, also by electronic means, of the implementation of your request.
